After the registration period is over, teams will be formed and you will be contacted. Teams consist of about 5 children. Students are placed on teams according to who they request to be with or others in similar grade and school. Every team needs a team manager. This is 1 or 2 parents who volunteer to lead the team meetings and see the team through the process of creating a solution to the team challenge. Team managers will receive as much training and guidance as they need in order to be successful managing their team! Please consider volunteering your time and talents. YOUR CHILD NEEDS YOU!!

Families on each team will decide when and where their meetings will be held. Meetings are usually 1 - 2 hours per week and can be at someone's home, at a school, public library, church, or any available meeting space.
